Recycle:

NEWSPAPERS

GLASS - recyclable glass is brown, green or clear

METAL CANS - food and beverage cans only

CORRUGATED CARDBOARD (WITH WAFFLING)

Category	Yes	No	How
Glass	Transparent glass Containers; green, brown or clear jars, & bottles.	Electric light bulbs, crystal, window & mirror glass, coffee mugs.	Remove cover (discard) rinse, & place container in recycling bin. Do not break glass.
Paper	Only Newspaper Including Inserts	Cellophane, plastic coated paper & cards, books & magazines, plastic of any kind	Keep clean & dry. Put newspaper in brown bag for easy removal. Place all newspaper in bin.
Metal	Metal Cans: Aluminum & other metals used as food containers	Foil food wrap, TV trays, pie tins, aluminum siding, spray & paint cans. Nothing part aluminum & plastic.	Rinse and remove label & place in bin.
Cardboard	Corrugated Cardboard only	Cereal/Shoe/Pizza boxes, waxed or plastic coated cardboard	Flatten bundle, string tie together not to exceed a 2x3 ft cube (2'x3'x2') and thirty-five (35) pounds in weight.

SPECIAL NOTES: Occasionally it may be necessary to leave behind an item in your recycling bin which cannot be recycled. This is to inform you of our recycling capabilities.
