RESIDENTS GUIDE TO SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL

DEAR VALUED CUSTOMER:

WE HAVE LISTED SOME HELPFUL TIPS WHICH WILL ALLOW OUR COMPANY TO SERVE YOU BETTER.

SCHEDULE:

- **TRASH** will be picked up one time per week.
- **RECYCLING** will be picked up every other week.

- Put container out the night before your collection day or before 6:00 A.M. on collection day. The ideal location is the left of your driveway when facing the street. Be sure that the **container handle faces your house** and the can is within 2 ft. of the road edge, and 3-4 ft from **obstructions** such as fences, lampposts, mailboxes, trees, cars, and recycling bins.

- Use your new dump cart (container) for **REGULAR SOLID WASTE** which consists of non recyclable normal household trash, garbage or rubbish created by a single family. **Place all trash inside the dump cart.** Plastic bags inside the dump cart are acceptable.

- **DO NOT OVERLOAD** container, the lid must be closed before dumping.

- **DO NOT USE** your dump cart for **HOT ASHES** or **FLAMMABLE** items.

- **DO NOT USE** your dump cart for **PAINT CANS** that contain paint or other liquid.

- **DO NOT USE** your dump cart for **GLASS** or **METAL FOOD CONTAINERS, NEWSPAPER, CORRUGATED CARDBOARD, LEAVES,** or **GRASS CLIPPINGS (yard waste).** These items should be recycled.

- **UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS** such as hazardous materials (i.e., oil based paints, automobile fluids, pesticides/rodenticides, fuel tanks/gas cans, compressed gas tanks), rocks, logs, stumps, tires, auto parts, will not be picked up. Also included as unacceptable is bulky waste which consists of scrap metal, furniture, TV antennas, mowers, appliances, mattresses, small automobile parts, odd pieces of construction debris, or other nonhazardous waste material.

- Extra containers are provided for an additional charge.

- Large items including bulky waste, sofas, refrigerators, lawnmowers, etc. can be picked up by special arrangement.

- Trash pickup will be delayed one day if your pickup day falls on the holiday or any day after for the following holidays: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Christmas Day, July 4th, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day.
