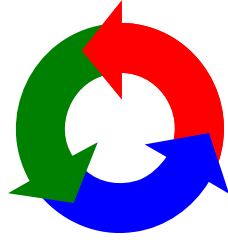


RECYCLING, IT'S THE LAW



Town of Suffield Recycling Guide

Newspaper, Magazines, and Catalogs:

All types of circulars and mail order catalogs may be included in PAPER BAGS (*No plastic bags please*) and placed in recycling bin.

Plastic Coated Paper Milk Cartons, Juice Cartons and Juice Boxes:

Please rinse, flatten and place in recycling bin.

Corrugated Cardboard:

Clean cardboard, flattened and cut to no larger than 3' x 3'. No plastic, waxed coated, or food contaminated cardboard accepted.

Glass and Metal Food & Beverage Containers:

Rinse and clean container, labels may be left on, place in bin. No aerosol cans.

Used Motor Oil:

Place used motor oil in non-breakable container with a fitting screw cap. Original oil container is recommended. If using a substitute container please label "Used Oil." Limit six quarts (6) per week.


Antifreeze:

Place used antifreeze in non-breakable container with a fitting screw cap. Original antifreeze container is recommended. If using a substitute container please label "Used Antifreeze." Limit one gallon (1) per week.

Plastic Containers:

One gallon maximum size. *Do not crush any plastic containers please.*

Only containers displaying the  or  designation on the container bottom are recyclable.

Do not recycle oil or antifreeze containers. Do not recycle the  containers with a mouth wider than the base (e.g. margarine tubs).

Discard these containers in the trash.
